Tenoroc Fishing and Archery Camp provides practical coaching for young anglers and basic archery training for beginning archers. Participants must be between the ages of 9 (or completed 3rd grade) and 15. The camp is staffed with certified instructors who are seasoned anglers and award-winning archery coaches.

- All aspects of fishing are covered including:
- Fish identification and ecology
 - Practice with different kinds of tackle
 - Various angling techniques
 - Fishing regulations
 - Cleaning and filleting skills
 - Boat navigation and safety

Attendees will leave with an appreciation for the sport of fishing, as well as the knowledge required for ethical angling. Campers will be provided with all the necessary gear. Upon successfully completing this program, each child will receive a rod and reel, tackle box, and tackle.

- The basics of International-style target archery are introduced including:
- Familiarization with archery equipment and terminology
 - Instruction in shooting techniques that create successful archers
 - Training in archery range safety rules and regulations
 - International-style scoring
 - Fun archery activities to build proficiency

Attendees will leave with an understanding of the sport of target archery, and the knowledge to practice it safely. Participants will use NASP - certified archery equipment during camp.
